Happy New Year, नववर्ष अभिनंदन

We are pleased to inform you that the year 2021 is very special for the Ramayana Centre as we will be completing 20 years of its existence. To mark the 20th anniversary, we are dedicating our annual calendar to the women characters who have important roles in the Ramayana and who have helped, in one way or the other, in moulding the great character of Shri Ram and in establishing the Ram Rajya, the most ideal “Rajya” to which Man aspires. Even Gandhiji’s dream was to implement Ram Rajya in India.

However, to achieve this supreme state, Shri Ram had to undergo innumerable challenges and hardships, which played a pivotal role in shaping his character.

Just like pure gold is recognised when burnt, similarly if Shri Ram had not experienced struggles and sacrifices during his penance of 14 years’ exile, he probably would not have become an exemplary king that demarcated him from others.

When King Dashratha decided to crown Shri Ram as King of Ayodhya, Manthara’s instigation forced Queen Kaikeyi to bring a negative twist in the story by asking the King a 14 year exile for Shri Ram.

Shri Ram humbly accepted the command with full respect to his parents, hence setting an example that although we face adverse situations in life, we can still deal with them in an optimistic manner and change them into opportunities.

The calendar for this year presents a few verses from Ramcharitmanas to illustrate the women characters namely, Manthara, Kaikeyi, Kausalya, Sita Mata, Sumitra, Sunayana, Ansuya Devi, Shoorpanakha, Shabri, Tara, and Mandodari. We present them in the sequence they have been depicted in the epic, starting with the most important incident, which is Shri Ram’s exile.

Kaikeyi and Manthara play significant roles in the plot development of the Ramayana. Despite being a learned woman, Kaikeyi, who initially was immersed in motherly love for Shri Ram, allows her maid Manthara to poison her mind against him.

Kausalya, being the Chief Queen and the mother of Shri Ram, could have used her veto power to stop him from going to the forest; but as a wise and value-oriented person, she advises Ramji to obey the command of his father and mother, Kaikeyi,

because a father and a mother together have more right on a child, than merely just a mother alone.

Sita ji, being the most ideal and devoted wife, convinces Shri Ram that she needs to be by his side when he is in a difficult situation and gives him the logic behind her decision.

When Lakshman decides to accompany his brother in his adversity, his mother, Sumitra does not only grant him permission to go, but also expresses her satisfaction and appreciation for Lakshman’s right decision, and preaches to him about his duty towards Shri Ram and Sita ji.

The role of Sunayana, Sita’s mother, though brief, is not least important. She incarnates the image of a devoted wife, an amicable mother and a sensible woman.

We find a glimpse of her character in Chitrakoot when Bharat comes to plea for Shri Ram to be coronated, instead of himself, as King of Ayodhya. Sunayana together with her husband King Janak come to meet everybody in Chitrakoot. Kausalya is very much worried and distraught about the decision that will be taken by Shri Ram and Bharat. Sunayana, though herself in the same mental state, consoles Kausalya very wisely.

Ansuya Devi boosts the morale of Sita Mata by appreciating her decision and by narrating to her the grandeur and importance of ‘pativrat’ dharma.

Shoorpanakha, the sister of Ravan, is instrumental in the abduction of Sita ji; she sows the seed of discord between Shri Ram and Ravan and urges her brother to seek revenge for her insult and preaches ‘Rajneeti’ to him.

Shabri, the great devotee of Shri Ram, advises Shri Ram to go to Pampa Lake and befriend Sugriva, who will help him in finding Sita Mata.

Tara is a wise lady. She advises her husband Vali to avoid any encounter with Sugriva who is no longer a meek and weak person as he has gathered confidence and strength after making an alliance with the mighty Shri Ram.

Mandodari, although wife to the evil Ravan, is a dignified woman; she makes a plea to Ravan to return Sita ji to Shri Ram, and ceaselessly tells him that his act of abducting Sita ji is immoral. She urges Ravan to change his course and to follow the path of dharma.

Finally, we want to say that, as always, the calendar has been prepared with lots of love and dedication; we hope that it will be appreciated.

We dedicate it to the devotees of Shri Ram. Any suggestions for future calendars are most welcome.
