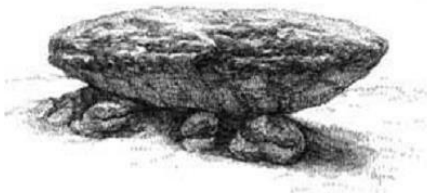

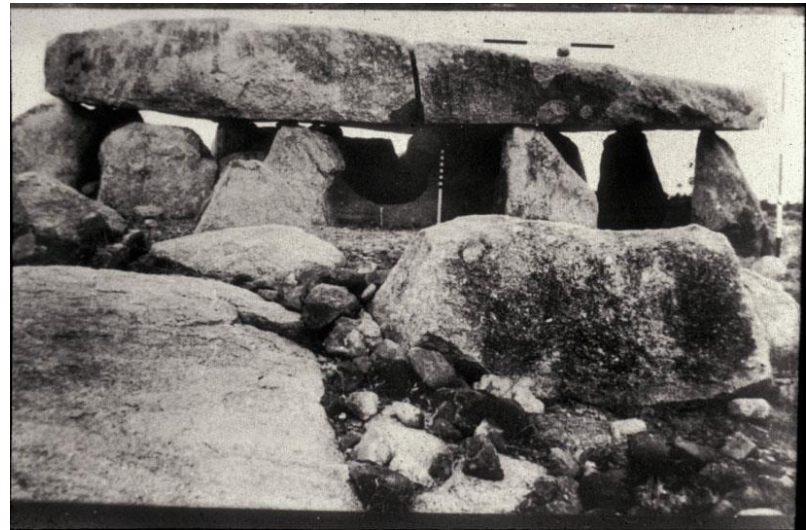

Prince of Ayodhya

- July 27, 48 AD
 - A ship with red sail arrived at Karak State, modern Kimhae city
 - 'I am the princess of Ayodhia'
 - Name, Huh Whang Ok
 - Age 16
 - She married to the local king, Kim Suro
 - 10 sons and 2 daughters, becoming the ancestors of Kim Clan & Huh clan-The largest population in Korea now
 - Huh Whang Ok's tomb is at Kimhae city

- Samkuk Yusa, the Chronicles of 3 kingdoms, compiled in 13th Century

The Queen of Boju

- Huh Whang Ok's
Posthumous title
Is the queen of
Boju

Boju is the old name of Anyue in China

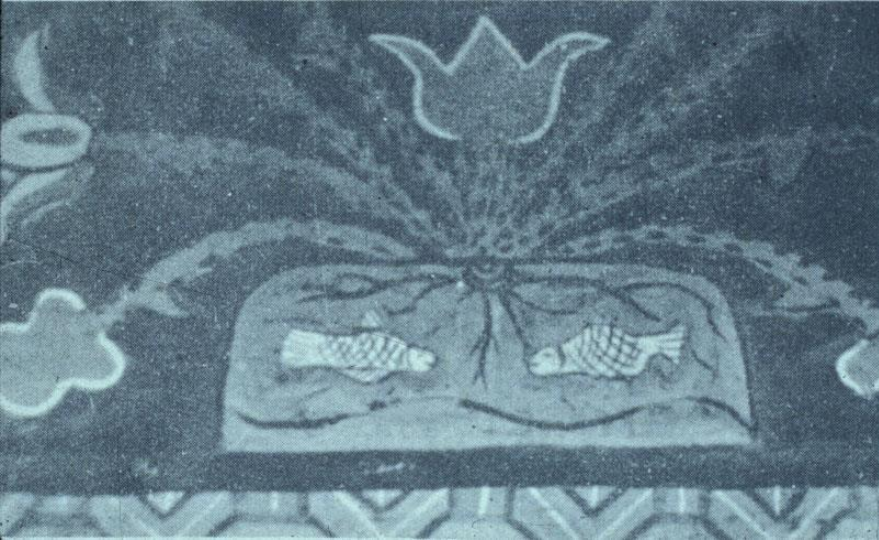

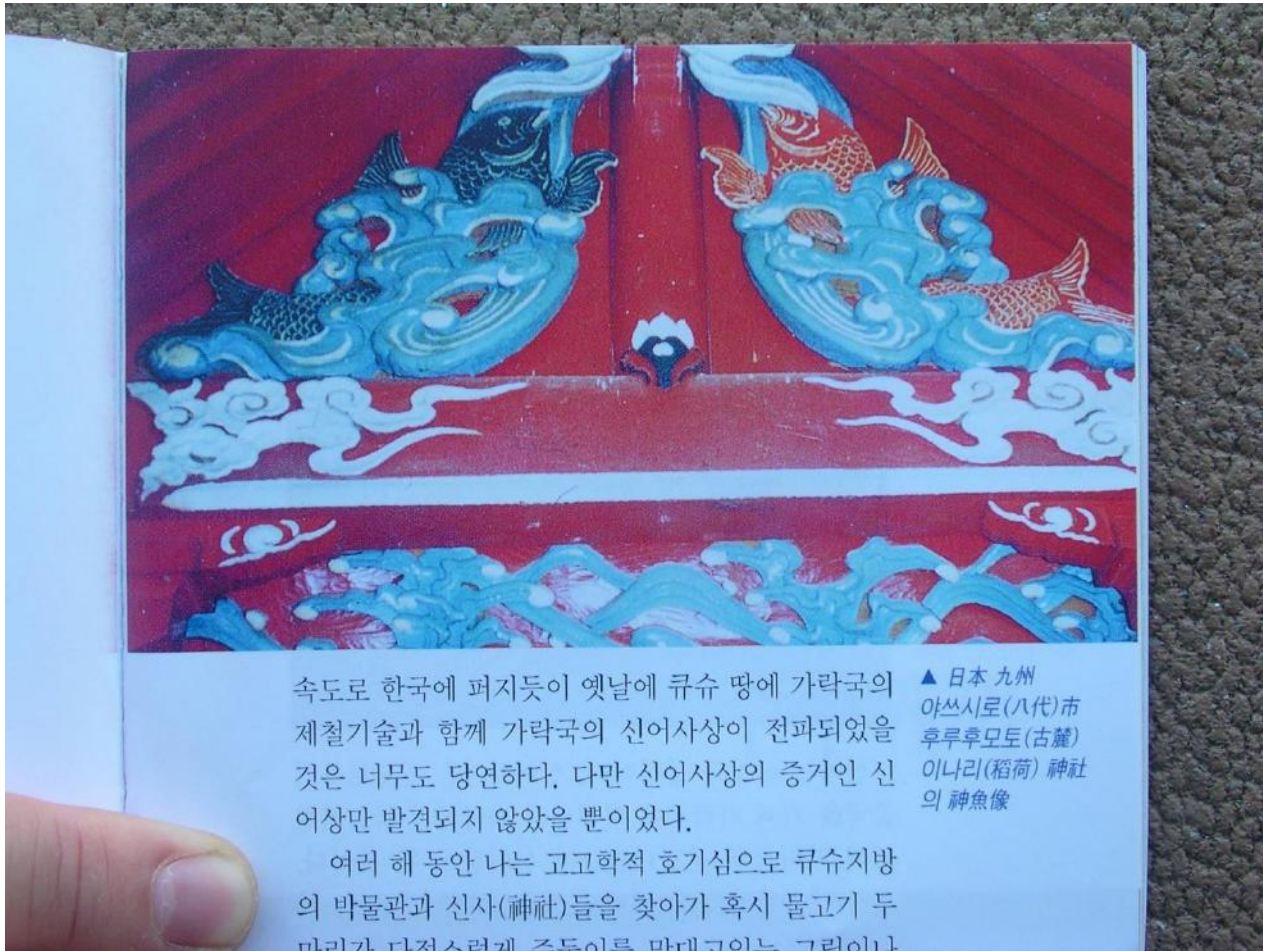
